

Why Use Carts?

What Are the Benefits?

Cleanliness

Roll-out carts keep odors in and vermin and animals out. They also have greater stability and the attached lid mitigates spills, keeping your streets clean!

User Friendliness

Roll-out carts contain many user-friendly features to make the disposal of household trash a more pleasant task.

Efficiency

Roll-out carts provide a method to collect household trash in an automated system.

Safety

Since automated trucks are utilized in the dumping process, roll-out carts are needed to meet the ever-increasing demands of safety regulations.

Do's

DO put your roll-out container out by 7:00am. Leave it out until the truck services it, and be sure to remove it from the road edge before 8:00pm. Contact City Hall for your designated pick-up-days.

DO keep the roll-out container off the curb and near your home on non-collection days. You will be protecting the container and improving the appearance of the neighborhood.

DO make sure coals from your fireplace or barbecue grill are cold. The containers will melt or burn when hot ashes are placed inside, so be very careful!

DO bag loose paper and trash, which can blow easily. This causes unwanted and unsightly litter in your neighborhood. Emptying the containers in this Texas wind can produce some spillage. "Bagged trash stops litter!"

DO maintain the cleanliness of the container. This will help to eliminate odors and bugs.

DO put the container close to but off of the curb on collection days so the truck can reach it. Move the handles so they are facing the house. Leave adequate spacing between your container and your neighbor's if placed in the same location.

DO keep all containers 5 feet away from each other, mailboxes, and automobiles.

Dont's

DON'T "JAM" trash into the container, as this can prevent it from being completely emptied.

DON'T utilize both sides of the can for collection. The driver does not stop to pick up boxes, etc. that are piled on the curb.

DON'T place household trash on the ground. All trash needs to be place in the container.

DON'T overload the container. Trash piled high can fall as the truck picks it up. Anything that falls out **WILL BE LEFT**.

DON'T take your container when you move to another home or out of the city limits. It is the property of the City.
