We are currently fully staffed, including one officer that is currently on light duty until the beginning of August.



We are currently working on in-house active shooter training at Early ISD which includes: ALERRT training, SWAT tactics training and hostage rescue training. This training also includes school walk throughs so the officers can keep their knowledge of the schools up to date.




Additionally, officers are partaking in TASER recertification training, SFST ARIDE/refresher training, Less Lethal Bean Bag Training. Some officers have taken Texas Gang training, along with an officer getting training to receive his Forensic and Investigative Sciences Level 1 training.

Officers have dealt with approximately 43 Domestic/Dissorderly/Assultive calls along with 8 DWI arrests. Officers have conducted a search warrant involving multiple people for fraud (stolen debit/credit cards – fake checks). Brown County Adult Probabation has worked with officers on multiple searches that have led to arrests, drug seizures, and felony weapon charges.

Officers have made 51 community relations calls, 53 animal calls, 25 funeral escort calls, 38 motorist assist calls and 105 suspicious/prowler calls.
