JULY - SEPTEMBER 2023

July was a busy month in the parks. We hosted the 14U District Tournament with teams from around the area competing to decide who would qualify the TTAB State Tournament. We also hosted the TTAB State Tournament for 10U baseball. This is the second year in a row we have had the honor of being chosen to host a state tournament at our facilities. This tournament is a week long, and brings hundreds of people from all over the state to our great city! This tournament fills all of our hotels, and keeps our local businesses extremely busy for that week.

In the month of August, we continued maintaining the parks after finishing up with the state tournament. We shifted most of our focus to the Town Center. We installed erosion matting and rip rap material along portions of the shorelines in preparation to begin adding water to the lake.

In the month of September, the parks department continued general park maintenance at all parks. We assisted the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department install fish habitats and the planting of aquatic plants. We also began level ups along both sides of the walking path. We finished the landscaping along Kelcy Way and Buena Vista's planting containers and around the parking lot.
