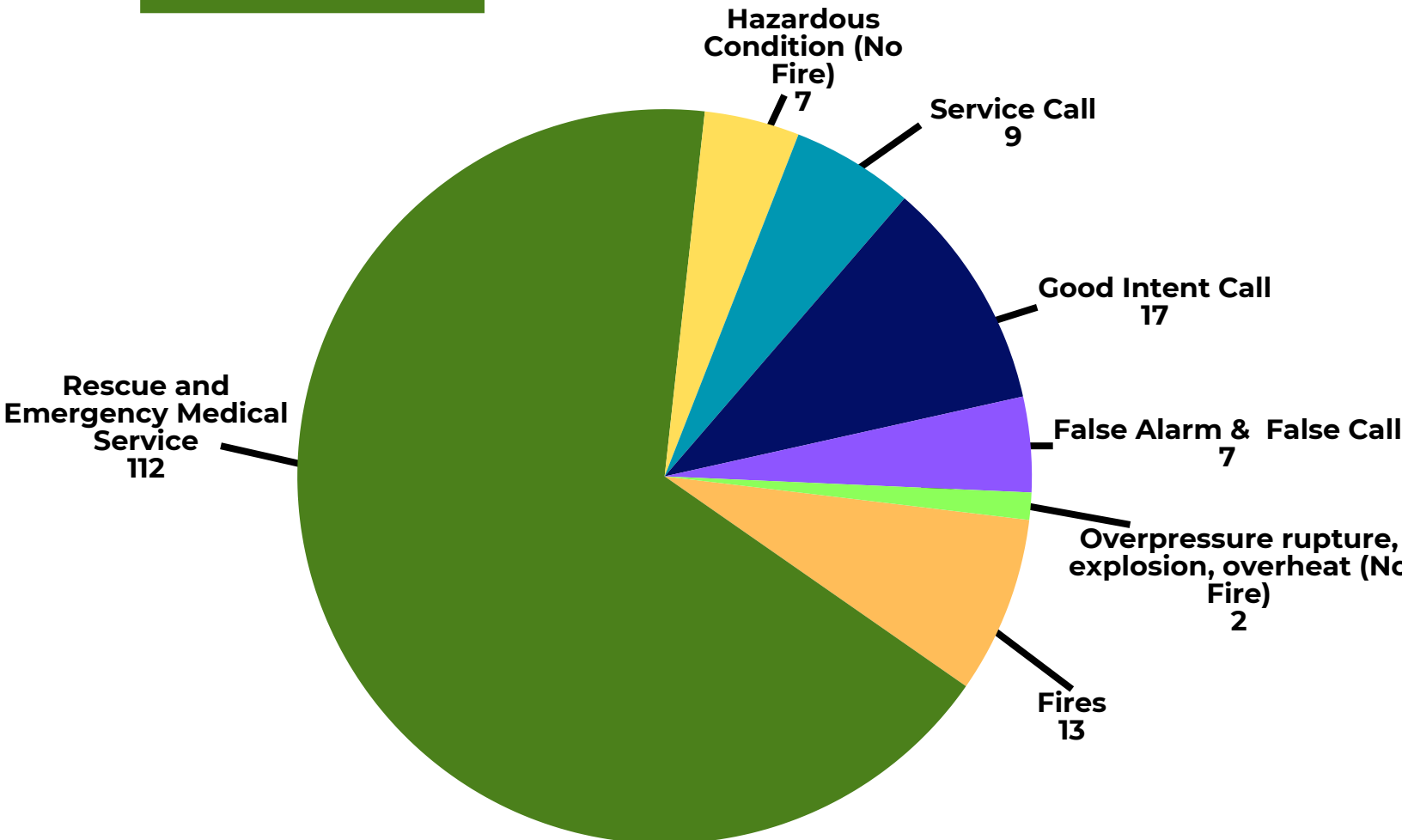
SPECIAL PROJECTS
