REPORT FOR Q3

APRIL - JUNE 2024

In the month of April, the Parks department was in full steam with baseball and softball. With all the spring rain we were very busy mowing and trying to keep up between the Town Center, City Park, and McDonald Park.

In the month of May, we were still marking and getting all 6 baseball and softball fields ready for games each night. We continued daily maintenance at all three parks. The parks department also helped with dirt work on Autumn Drive, doing level ups on both sides of the road after curbs were poured.

In June we closed out the softball season, but baseball continued. We still had to mark and maintain four fields daily. We finished off the baseball season by hosting the TTAB district 10U tournament. The parks department installed nearly 2,000 feet of poly line for irrigation at the Town Center for new trees. We then planted around 40 new trees and installed individual irrigation emitters at each tree.
