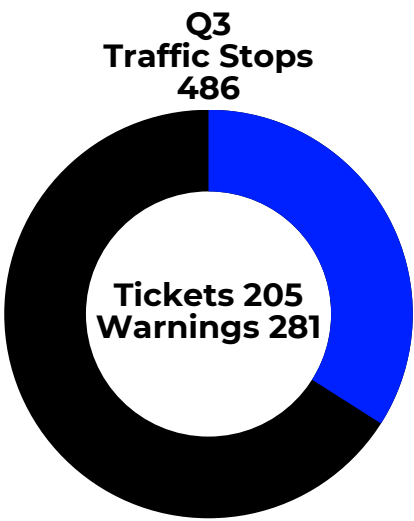
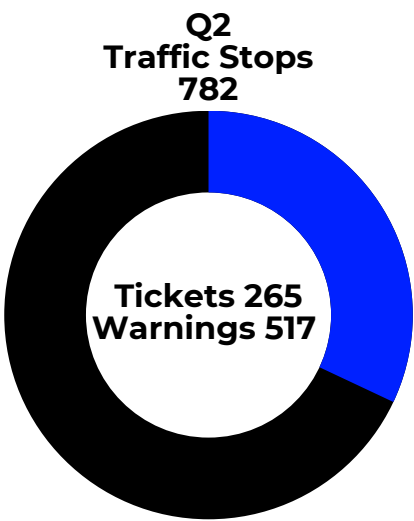
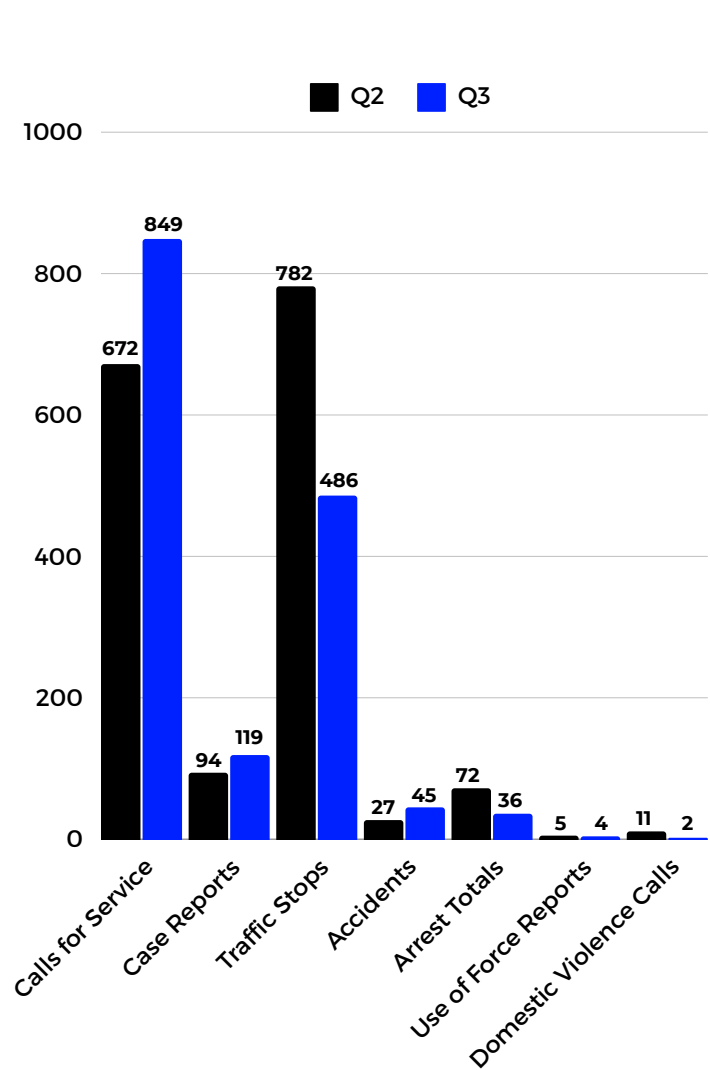

**We have applied for 100% grant for a phone recorder for the department - \$13000. We are told by COG it has been approved, waiting on official notice.**

**We have applied for 100% grant for additional shields, this would put 1 in each patrol car - \$23,000. – Still no news.**

**Officers continue to work extra hours on STEP enforcement. Selective Traffic Enforcement Program – where TxDot pays for officers overtime to enforce traffic violations on highways in Early.**

# SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICER

**50/50 agreement between Early ISD and City of Early where an officer works all the school campuses during school hours then works patrol for the City when school is not in session. Officers pay is divided between the City and the District 50/50**

**April and May were slow months inside the school, everyone getting ready to get out and testing. Officer Tobias has been working patrol shifts helping cover vacations and days off from other officers. Officer Tobias has also attended an update for SRO schools this month. She will move back into SRO duties on August 1st.**

# TRAINING

---

**The Early Police Department hosted 2 separate ALERRT Active Shooter classes in June. ALERRT is based through San Marcos Texas State University. It trains officers all over the world in a variety of active shooter classes and major incident scene management. It was named the National Standard in Active Shooter response by the FBI.**

**We are honored to be able to host these classes here in Early and have officers from many departments around Texas attend. All Early Police officers attended and many officers from out of town traveled here to attend the classes. These classes are free of charge (grant funded) and provide valuable training for active shooter and active incident training.**
