DECORATING RULES



To secure a spot on the Holly Jolly Tree Trail, make a minimum of \$10 donation to the City of Early Beautification Commission. These donations allow the City to keep Early beautiful!

SETUP

You can begin decorating your tree on December 4th.

All trees must be decorated by December 8th

If your tree is not decorated by 8am on December 9th, your spot will go to the next person in line if all spots are taken.

TAKE DOWN

Removing decorations from trees begins on January 1st.

Decorations must be removed by January 8th.

Spots are 1st come; 1st serve and limited. So, get your spot early!! If all spots are not filled by sign up deadline, we reserve the right to change your spot number

DECORATING GUIDELINES

The City of Early will provide each decorator with one live Christmas tree and electricity.

Decorators must provide their own decorations and lighting. Ladders will not be provided.

Standard trees measure between 6-8 feet in height. Because we offer fresh cut trees, we cannot guarantee the width or shape of every tree.

Decorators must provide one min. 15ft. outdoor-rated extension cord. Any additional cords must be outdoor-rated. We reserve the right to pull any extension cords that do not meet the qualifications. No power strips allowed.

Use LED Outdoor lights only. We reserve the right to remove any lights that are not LED. We recommend using 4-5 strands of LED outdoor lights per tree. Lights should be strung with the male end of the plug coming from the bottom of the tree.

Drilling into the fence is NOT allowed. Hammering any items into the ground is not allowed.

Edible items used to decorate are prohibited including, but not limited to, candy canes, popcorn, and birdseed. They attract wildlife and compromise the safety of the environment.

It can get Windy! Please secure all decorations to your tree using pipe cleaners, small zip ties, or other string/ties. Ornament hooks can be used if the ends are secured.
